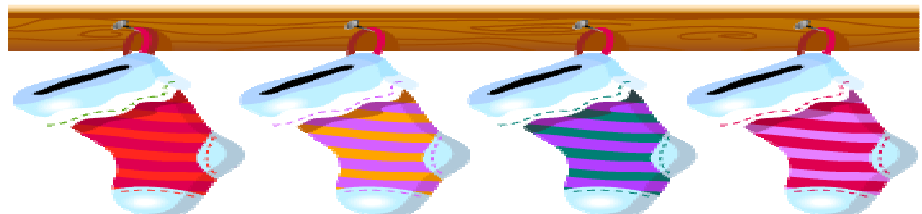
### Token Question:
