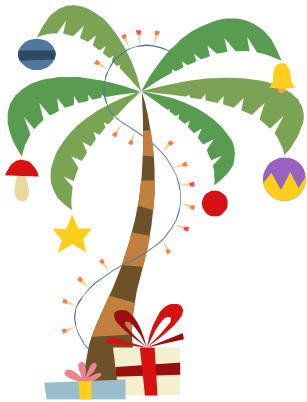


Mrs. Lundquist's 5th Grade Newsletter
