2. The rest of the report is going to give us general information about the science behind your topic such as: electricity, magnetism, buoyancy, etc.
3. At least different THREE sources must be used when writing your research.
4. Reports must be 1-2 pages long and typed. Times Roman Font 12, double spaced.
5. A bibliography will accompany the paper. Easybib.com is where students should go to cite their sources.

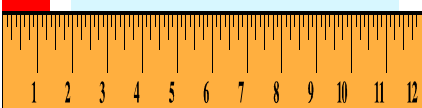
